5. INSTALLATION

Use only as directed. Be sure all surfaces to be cleaned are swept or vacuumed to remove loose debris. Wipe up any excess oil or grease. Avoid skin and eye contact with product. Wear protective eyewear, gloves, long sleeves, and long pants while handling concentrate. Ensure work area is well-ventilated during application. Keep children and pets out of the area during application and drying.

Dilute concentrated cleaner with warm water according to the following mixing chart:

Use	PERMAGAURD Cleaner & Degreaser	Warm Water
Heavy Duty	1 Part	2 Parts
Medium Duty	1 Part	4 Parts
General Purpose Cleaner	1 Part	8 Parts

Pour diluted mixture onto the floor and allow to dwell for 20 minutes (tough stains may require additional time). Mist surface to keep damp. Work product into surface with a stiff bristle broom or brush. Rinse area well with clean water or power wash to remove all residue. Re-apply if necessary for extremely dirty

surfaces or hard to remove stains. Allow 24 hours minimum prior to sealing or coating.

Product may be used as a general purpose cleaner on epoxy coated surfaces when diluted at 1:8 ratio. Always test in a small inconspicuous area to determine ease of use and desired results.

8. MAINTENANCE

The long term performance, appearance, and life expectancy of wear surface products are critically dependent upon a good routine maintenance program. PERMAGUARD floor coating systems are nonporous, causing dirt and contaminants to remain on the surface. The use of properly placed mats, inside and outside, will help increase the life of the floor. Recommend maintenance program consist on frequent sweeping of debris from the surface and thorough cleaning utilizing a neutral pH cleaner (i.e. STONETECH Stone & Tile Cleaner). Frequency of sweeping and washing will vary depending on floor usage type, traffic and age.
